

The 2010 Virginia CFO Awards

ELIGIBILITY - Nominee must be a chief financial officer or hold an equivalent position in a public or private company based in Virginia. Nominations are due by May 14, 2010.

AWARDS - The Virginia CFO Awards will be given in five categories:

- Public company CFO
- Private company CFO (Small company - fewer than 100 employees)
- Private company CFO (Large company - 100 employees or more)
- Nonprofit/foundation CFO (Small company - fewer than 100 employees)
- Nonprofit/foundation CFO (Large company - 100 employees or more)

The five winners will be announced at an awards banquet.

AWARDS HONORS - All nominees will be recognized at the awards program. Winners and nominees will also be recognized in our August issue.

SELECTION PROCESS - An independent judging panel will select winners based on information provided by nominating firms, including a brief narrative and any supporting documents.
