WHY IS THIS FUNDING NEEDED?

- The 25-year-old legacy core tax processing and accounting system (IRMS) is in need of replacement with a modern, integrated tax system.
- ** The obsolete technology of the legacy system creates security vulnerabilities, putting taxpayer data at risk.
- ** IRMS is responsible for administering and processing tax returns responsible for 95% of the Commonwealth's General Fund Revenue.
- * Business case for IRMS replacement:
 - Ability to implement legislative policy changes more quickly and efficiently at a lower cost.
 - Improved data analytics capabilities to aid in decision-making.
- - Improved taxpayer portals and self-service for taxpayers, tax professionals and
